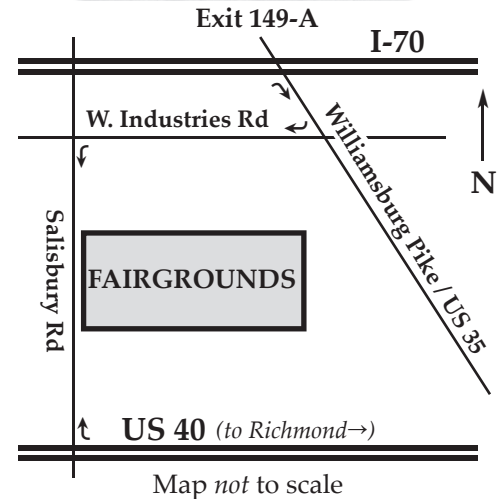


Fourth Annual Old Time Truck Show!

Old Time Truck Show Safety Rules

1. Common sense and courtesy are expected from everyone.
2. Vehicles may be operated only by legally licensed drivers; all parts must be in good working order if the vehicle is driven on the fairgrounds; fuel tanks must be capped; all vehicles must have a fire extinguisher.
3. All parked vehicle must be secured with chock blocks; all items carried on truck/trailer must be securely fastened down.
4. All vehicles must be covered by the owner's liability insurance, unless brought in on a trailer and not unloaded.
5. No alcoholic beverages or tobacco are allowed on the fairgrounds.
